Who has the tools? Owl does.



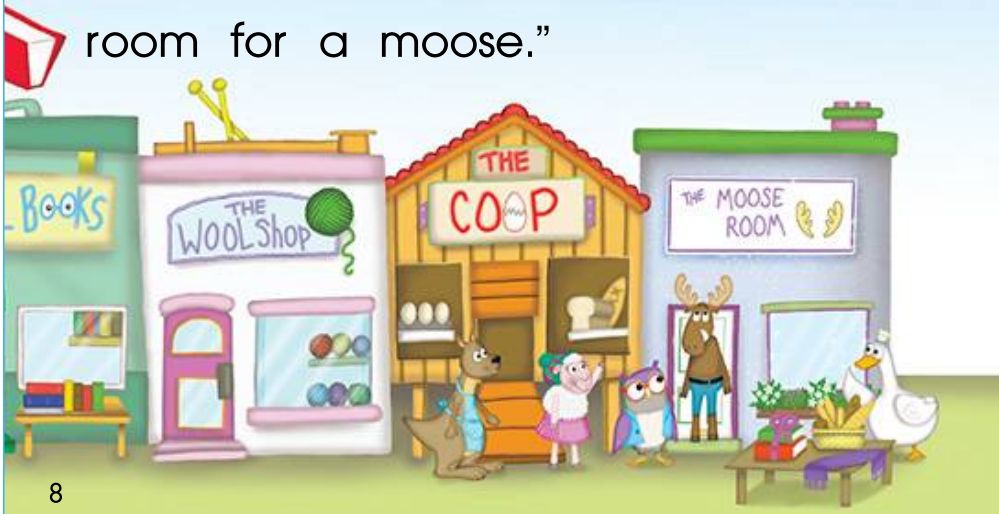
They worked hard and were done
