

Present Tense Verbs

Present tense verbs tell about actions that are happening right now. When the subject is singular, add **-s** or **-es** to the end of most verbs to make the present tense form. Do not add **-s** when the subject is plural.

Al likes the color purple.

Cara and Raul water the plants.
